Thursday, October 4th going into Friday, October 5th - (Monthly) – Estimated 120 Tuesday, October 16th going into Wednesday, October 17th (Major) – Estimated 195 Wednesday, October 24th going into Thursday, October 25th (Monthly) – Estimated 150

Recommendations: We recommend continued visits to stay on top of the Cane toad population. If possible, we would recommend for someone to meet in the morning (6AM) after the next visit to see the quantity removed from property. Or we can check in with the security guard at the gate.

## November Visits are scheduled for the following dates;

Thursday, November 15<sup>th</sup> going into Friday, November 16<sup>th</sup> (Monthly) Tuesday, November 20<sup>th</sup> going into Wednesday, November 21<sup>st</sup> (Major) Tuesday, November 27<sup>th</sup> going into Wednesday, November 28<sup>th</sup> (Monthly)

The areas of concern that have been reported and checked thoroughly during visits; Meravi Court, San Lucas Lane, Speranza Way

The toads are attracted to the lakes within Palmira, but disperse into the HOA to find food and hiding spots. We recommend Owners take away hiding spots around their home. Thin out landscape from the ground up so toads do not find a place to hide out in the bushes. Remove any items on property that can hold water.
